Re: Explanation for the decrease of more than 10% in Profit after Tax for the Q2/2026 compared with the corresponding period of 2025

Pursuant to the Law on Securities No. 54/2019/QH14 dated 26 November 2019, Circular No. 96/2020/TT-BTC dated 6 November 2020 of the Ministry of Finance on information disclosure in the securities market, and the Information Disclosure Regulations of the Hanoi Stock Exchange.

Based on the Company's Financial Statements for the second quarter of 2026, Chan May Port Joint Stock Company (Ticker ID: CMP) hereby provides the following explanation for the decrease of more than 10% in the Company's Profit after Corporate Income Tax for the second quarter of 2026 compared with the corresponding period of 2025:

Although the Company's revenue for the second quarter of 2026 increased significantly compared with the corresponding period of 2025 (by more than VND 29 billion), the increase was primarily attributable to service activities with relatively low profit margins. As a result, the Company's Profit after Corporate Income Tax for the second quarter of 2026 decreased by more than 13% compared with the corresponding period of 2025 (a decrease of more than VND 1 billion).

The above matters are fully disclosed in the Notes to the Financial Statements for the second quarter of 2026.

The above represents the principal reasons for the decrease of more than 10% in the Company's Profit after Tax for the current reporting period compared with the corresponding period of 2025.
