3. Supervising the Board of Management by the Board of Directors

The BOD regularly monitored and supervised the activities of the BOM and collaborates with the BOS to inspect and oversee all activities of the BOM in performing their assigned duties based on the Charter and the Regulations on the Organization and Operation of the BOD. The BOD refrains from direct intervention in the CEO's operational duties, supporting the CEO in effectively implementing resolutions and decisions from the General Meeting of Shareholders and the BOD.

3.1. Oversight of the first 6 moths 2026

During the first six months of 2026, the global crude oil market continued to experience significant volatility and complexity, driven by a range of economic, political, and geopolitical factors. Crude oil prices fluctuated widely as OPEC+ adjusted its production increase roadmap to stabilize the market, while the outlook for global economic growth and energy demand remained weak. In addition, geopolitical tensions in the Middle East, particularly around the Strait of Hormuz, together with the Russia–Ukraine conflict and the trade policies of major economies, heightened market uncertainty, resulting in unpredictable movements in crude oil and refined petroleum product prices.

Domestically, the petroleum market continued to be affected by fluctuations in global oil prices, the domestic fuel price management mechanism, and the slow recovery in fuel demand. Meanwhile, the ongoing shift toward fuel-efficient alternatives and cleaner energy sources continued to put pressure on the Corporation's sales volume, profit margins, and overall business performance.

In response to the above developments, the Board of Directors closely monitored market conditions, strengthened its oversight, and promptly directed the Board of Management to implement flexible management measures to mitigate risks, ensure a stable supply, enhance business performance, and achieve the Corporation's planned objectives. The key directives are summarized as follows:

- Production and Business Operations: Direct, urge, and supervise the Executive Board in implementing the production and business plan as well as other key tasks for 2026 as assigned by the General Meeting of Shareholders and the BOM. The BOM identified

and leveraged development opportunities to increase business output, expand market share, and optimize the operation of petroleum terminal systems.

- Debt Management: Enhance debt management efforts to prevent new bad debts, closely monitor overdue debts, and actively pursue the recovery of outstanding and uncollectible debts, ensuring healthy financial conditions.

- Corporate Governance and Service Quality Improvement: Continue to strengthen the implementation and maintenance of initiatives to improve the quality of petroleum storage services, expand PVOIL Easy services, and promote integrated payment solutions, including PVOIL Easy and PVOIL 4U, thereby enhancing retail sales performance across the Corporation's petrol station network. Continue to accelerate digital transformation and the adoption of Industry 4.0 technologies to improve governance, operational efficiency, and overall business performance.

The BOD consistently maintained close and effective coordination with the BOM and the BOS in implementing resolutions of the General Meeting of Shareholders and the BOD, ensuring compliance with laws and internal regulations in the management and operational activities of the corporation.

3.2. Supervision Results

The BOM properly performed the assigned functions and tasks, managing the production and business operations of the Corporation in line with the goals and directions set by the General Meeting of Shareholders and the BOD. In the face of market challenges, the BOD directed the BOM to continuously strive, reassess the system, and implement synchronized business solutions. Sales volume in the first six months of 2026 reached 242 thousand m³, equivalent to 138% of the target for the first six months of 2026. Profit amounted to VND 2.03 billion, exceeding the profit target approved by the General Meeting of Shareholders. Investment and development of petrol stations through various forms were strengthened, resulting in the completion of 04 petrol stations in the first six months of 2026, surpassing the planned targets. In corporate management and operations, the CEO and Executive Board complied with relevant legal regulations, performed their functions and tasks as prescribed in the Corporation's Charter and internal governance regulations, and fully and seriously implemented the resolutions and decisions of the General Meeting of Shareholders and BOM with positive results. They directed the Corporation's operations according to the approved strategy and strictly followed disclosure regulations for public companies.

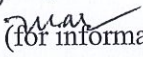
